



New Kitten Check List

○ Litter box + Scoop

- Rule of thumb 1 litterbox per cat + 1 additional.



○ Toys

- Many cats lack exercise and mental stimulation, adding toys allows your cat to use its natural behavior of hunting as well as giving it exercise to prevent obesity.

○ Cat Tree

- Cat trees are an excellent tool to promote environmental enrichment and allows your cat to have a safe place to hide and not be bothered.

○ Scratching Post

- All cats have an urge to scratch, it's how they communicate, stretch and perfect their claws! Giving him his own place to scratch can help prevent him from scratching your furniture and allowing him to freely do what instincts have taught him to do.

○ Treats

- Just like us, cats love treats! Be sure it's a healthy snack and to not give too many.

○ Bowls

- Puzzle bowls and balls alike are excellent choices to keep his mind busy and belly full!

○ Food

- Deciding on a food is always a hard choice, buy what's in your budget and be sure it has a life stage. Cats should have some wet food (50%) in their diet to help prevent urinary issues such as crystals and stones.



○ Carrier

- A carrier will be necessary to keep your cat safe while traveling.



○ Nail Trimmers

- Keeping your cats nails cut short will minimize the destruction of scratching and keep your hands safe too!

○ Brush

- Cats are pretty good at cleaning themselves though sometimes our long-haired cats get matted fur, brushing daily is key.
